#### **Assessment methods:**

Pending a semester there will be assessed the attendance and participation of students in workshops.

A student can gain 30 points for participation and 20 points for attendance. For assessment "A" is needed to achieve at less 45 points, for "B" at least 40 points, for "C" at least 35 points, for "D" at least 30 points and for assessment "E" at least 25 points.

Credits will not be granted to that student who does not obtain minimum of 10 points for his attendance.

### **Learning outcomes of the course unit:**

The course practically joins to gained knowledge in other courses. Students know to cooperate with media and so to prove, as future experts of political science, to give the written and audiovisual opinions. **Students** are, beside of qualitative rhetoric, accustomed to confront a camera and do not have any problem with the live entry into a television discussions.
